

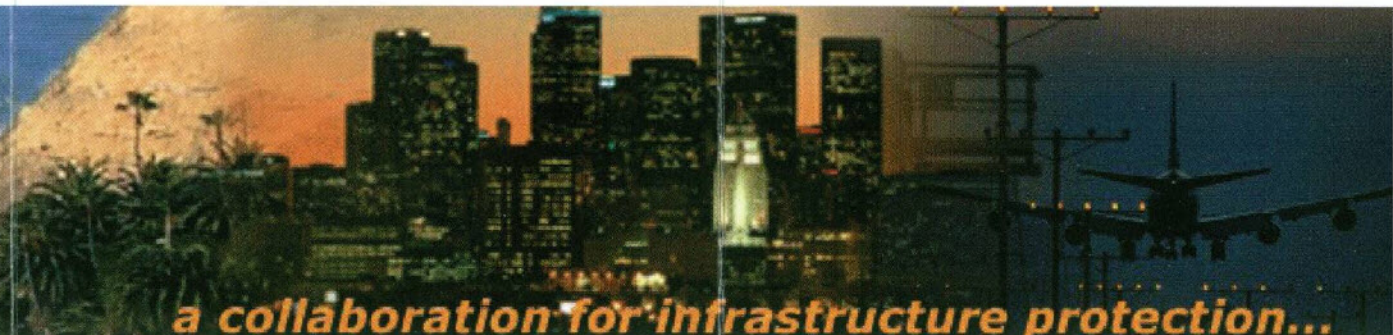

INFRAGARD HISTORY

The InfraGard program began in 1996 as a collaborative effort between private sector cyber professionals and the FBI field office in Cleveland, Ohio. The FBI later expanded the program to every field office in the country.

TODAY

Today, we have 86 chapters across the county with a membership in excess of 42,000. In Los Angeles the InfraGard chapter has more than 1600 members.

WHO SHOULD JOIN?

Our members are typically members of the physical or data security efforts associated with America's critical infrastructures and key resources (CIKR) or vendors to these organizations. Some of our members are also members of law enforcement.



OUR MISSION

Our mission is information sharing.

We share information through daily briefing emails, membership meetings and relevant training, generally free to our members.

INFRAGARD LOS ANGELES

InfraGard Los Angeles is recognized as a leader in creating effective partnerships between law enforcement and our CIKR membership.

- We are an integral part of the FBI's private sector outreach program.
- We are the formal private sector outreach vehicle for the Joint Regional Intelligence Center (JRIC), Southern California's major criminal and terrorism threat fusion center.
- Our Program Manager and FBI Coordinator are housed at the JRIC.
- Our training is recognized nationally as facilitating strong relationships and co-



operation between law enforcement and our members.

- Our members identify and report an average of two tips or leads regarding potential terrorism threats per week.



WHY JOIN?

Our members, through participating in our programs and training, have the opportunity to meet and develop functional relationships with other CIKR security personnel as well as sworn law enforcement. These relationships provide access to the most current information available regarding threats, threat mitigation procedures and technology, a community of individuals with common interests in protecting our critical infrastructures and ready access to assistance when presented with a threat. Perhaps most importantly, InfraGard enhances its members' abilities to help protect America. Dues are a nominal \$25 dollars a year.
